## HISTORIC INTEREST:

THEME: Religion; Architecture - 20th Century DATE: 1911, 1952  
DESCRIPTION: Built by Portland contractor, Edward Killfeather, for \$75,000, this building acts as the seat of government for the Oregon Province of Sisters of the Holy Name. The Order was founded in Montreal, Canada in 1843. The central portion of the building and the south wing were built in 1911. The east and north wings and the maintenance were added in 1957.

STYLE: Italian Villa - Modern STORIES: 3

SIDING: Stucco and brick.  
ROOF: Multiple hip roofs with central spire.  
DOORS: Paneled (some replaced with aluminum)  
WINDOWS: Variety of forms include multi-light fixed pane, 1/1 double-hung, fan lights, transom lights, brick tracery and preponderance of classical (contd. on back)  
MAIN ENTRANCE: Added in 1952 entrance is highlighted by compound, rectangular brick relief with inscription: "Convent of the Holy Names" and decorative east stone plaque below belt course. Lamps flank door.  
NOTES: The brick in this structure is from the old Oswego foundry. On the rear elevation massive Tuscan columns and plain pilasters flank a glazed and paneled door with multi-light transom. Pedimented gable with partial return. Scagliola & medallion in tympanum. Cast stone balcony above. Round-headed opening to balcony. Fan-light & windows with brick surrounds. Flanking windows have flat lintels (contd. on back)

OTHER: Hipped bell tower; hipped dormer; third floor projecting porch in e. elevation; classically-inspired details; some filled w/ sash windows at later date, exposed rafters

CONDITION:

EXTERIOR ALTERATIONS/ADDITIONS: Door replaced e. elevation; window openings filled; main addition on n. elevation  
NOTEWORTHY LANDSCAPE FEATURES: Old fruit orchard e. of brick building foundations plantings hedges, mature deciduous and amifeous trees

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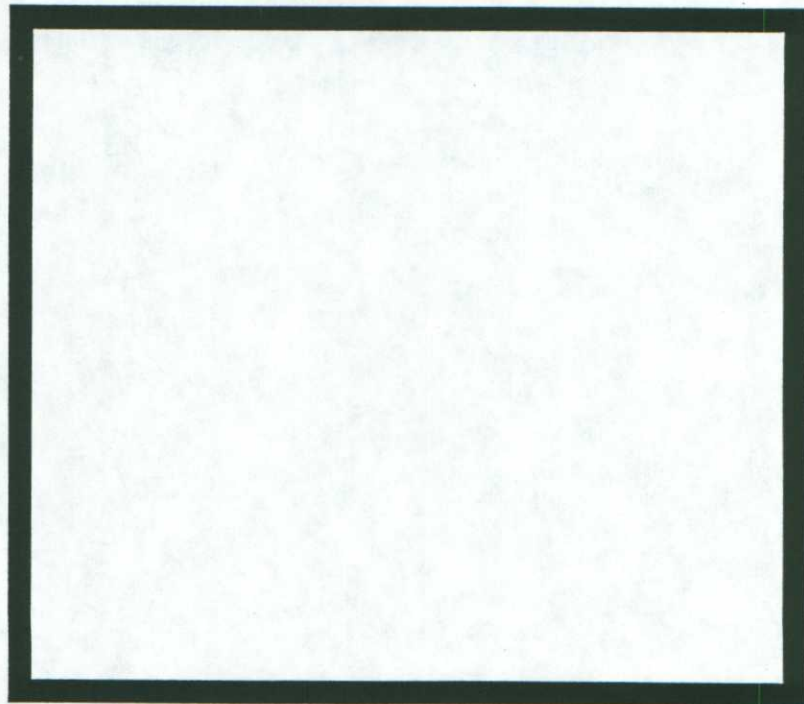
