



Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

The Boyd homestead is a frame building of two stories with a single story wing added on. The roofing material is shingle and the siding is board and batten. Windows are double hung 1 over 1.

The Boyd family-consisting of Charles and Annie Boyd and three children-came to the area in 1904 and established a ranch on 600 acres. The operation included a slaughter-house and a retail store in Bend. In 1980, the house was moved to its present location and entered into the NRHP.
