Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

Maintained as storage building.

School is 20 x 30 with a 16 x 20 addition. Unpainted, used for storage. Prior use as chicken house. Windows on south side added, then covered. Original building had three windows north and south side. Flag pole above front entrance.

One of few remaining one-room school buildings in Deschutes county. Lumber came from Dorrance mill on Melvin Creek. District 45.
