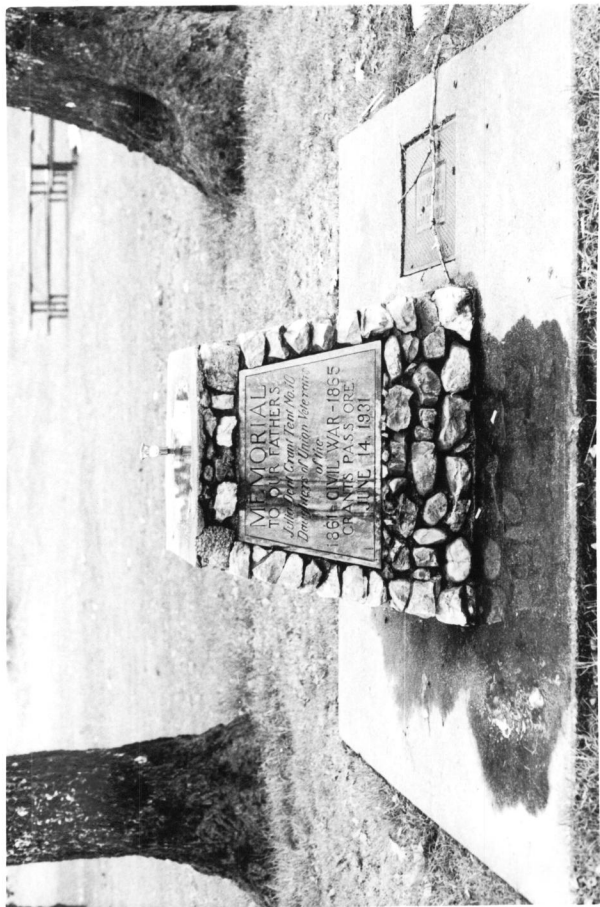

Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

The Union Veterans Memorial Fountain Landmark is a stone plaque mounted in a rubble stone drinking fountain base located in the Grants Pass City Park on the south bank of the Rogue River. The plaque reads:

*"Memorial to our Fathers, Julia Dent Grant Tent No. 10,
 Daughters of Union Veterans of the Civil War, 1861-
 1865. Grants Pass, Ore. June 14, 1931."*
