historical significance:

The Weddle Covered Bridge, erected in 1937, is a span of 120 feet across Thomas Creek. It stands on Kelley Road west of Scio, Oregon, and is downstream about one mile from the Gilkey Covered Bridge. This bridge has a vertical board and batten exterior and a gable roof covered with sheet metal. The exterior boards flare at the base. The bridge is open on the east and west elevations for lighting.

The truss arrangement is as follows:
