Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

1395 Mission Street SE is a house of predominantly East Lake Cottage styles and with touches of Queen Anne Style, primarily distinguished by its gabled and multi-leveled roof. On the front of the gable are ornamental designs of sunbursts and woodworked trims. The house has paneled windows and a stone foundation. Little is known of the history of the house, except that it was owned by Frank V. Barquist from 1928 until his death in 1934, whereupon it became property of his widow, Ida Barquist, until at least 1942. Barquist was a business partner in the firm of Thatcher and Barquist, but the profession of this firm is not known.
