Red clay tile roof with copper finials on towers. Massive joined chimneys. Smooth stucco exterior walls. Multi-light round-arched and square sash windows. Massive round tower with bellcast dome. Covered walkway leading to bathhouse with pyramidal roof, leaded glass doors and windows, and decorative cast stone ornaments. Bronzed wrought-iron gates around main entry. Various turrets, bay windows, and arcades.
