This red brick building has some terra cotta but not enough to be included in the official glazed terra cotta group. It originally had more at the first floor level. It is not a very interesting building in its present condition.

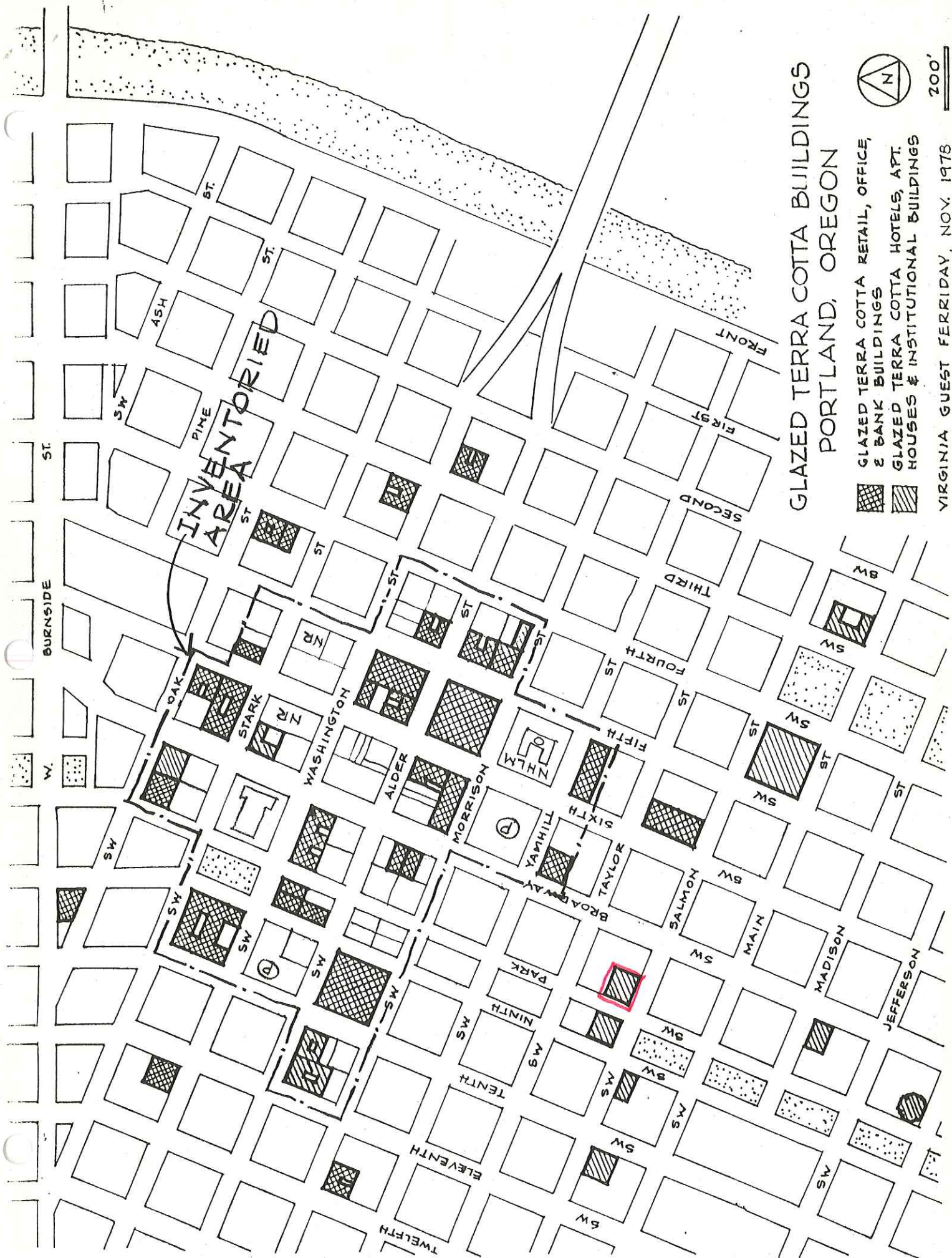
