STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Architectural: The commercial building, constructed in 1884 by the Richards family, was constructed in the Western False Front style. The building was occupied by Sullivan's Grocery in 1940. Characteristics of the style embodied in the building include the high parapeted stepped roof, projecting bracketed cornice with dentilated frieze, recessed panels between the brackets, shiplap siding, four over four double-hung wood sash windows, tall storefront windows with paneled bulkhead, transom over upstair entrance door, and recessed main entrance. A small one story addition has been added to the south side of the building constructed during the historic period. In good condition with minor alterations, the commercial building is an excellent example of its type.

<u>Historical</u>: The property is associated with the following Portland families or businesses: R.B. Wilson, Ebenezer Richards, Herbert L. Edward A. and Annie Richards, Hazel M. and C.B. Miller.

PROPERTY OWNERSHIP HISTORY

1883	R.B. Wilson deeded the property to Ebenezer J.Richards.
1917	Ebenezer J.Richards died. Estate # 14117.
1945	Herbert L. Richards ruled imcompetent.
1945	Edward A. and Annie Richards deeded the property to Hazel M. Miller. The Bank on behalf of Miller deeded the property to John and Helen Bozick.

OWNERS' BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION

Ebenezer J. Richards, according to the 1883 Portland city directory, was living at 295 Nineteenth N. At that time he was working as a grocer at the same address. According to the 1916 Directory, Ebenezer Richards lived with his wife, <u>Mary</u>, at the same address.

Herbert Richards, No biographical information is currently known.

Annie Richards, No biographical information is currently known.

Hazel M. Miller, No biographical information is currently known.




