Engineering, Transportation: The Vista Bridge replaced the Ford Street Bridge, dismantled and relocated as the present Terwilliger overpass.

Social: Of the total cost of \$197,000 the city paid approximately one-quarter and the residents the remainder.

The contract of concrete with composers are of original, unaltered detailing. There are 4 refuge possessing seven pentangular, pointed bronze spikes at top of concrete railings. The support ribs are of reinforced steel with cement molding. Rolled steel hand railing along inside of concrete baluster toppings between the intricate entrance pylons the four corners of the bridge structure. Detailing includes 600 concrete spokes, recessed bronze conduits, bronze and iron to ornaments on portal posts and eight concrete flower boxes that line sidewalks on side of the bridge.	bays, each he arched ngs run that mark bracket either
