Abstract/Summary Comments: Accept Boundary Decrease and Additional Documentation. The SHPO has provided sufficient evidence for the removal/boundary decrease of certain areas of the 2008-listed Oregon State Hospital Historic District. The documentation also revises the description of the remaining district to reflect significant alterations to the historic campus. The revised acreage (92.3) and resource count (36 contributing resources and 4 non-contributing resources) reflect recent modernization efforts that significantly affected the historic district. While the modern (post 2012) work resulted in the demolition of several contributing resources and their replacement with a large intrusion to the east of the main buildings, the district on a whole retains sufficient integrity to convey its historic and architectural significance.

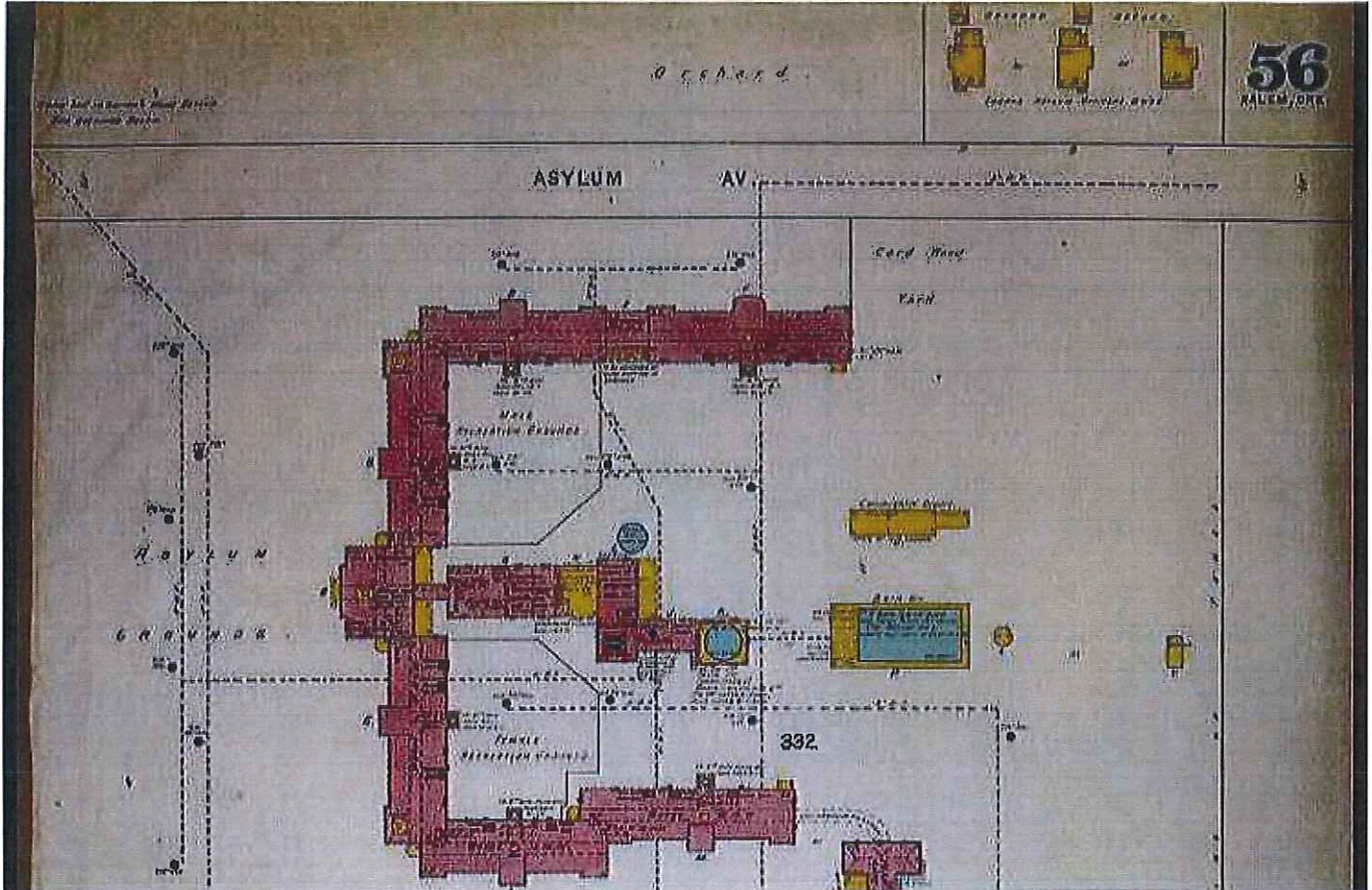

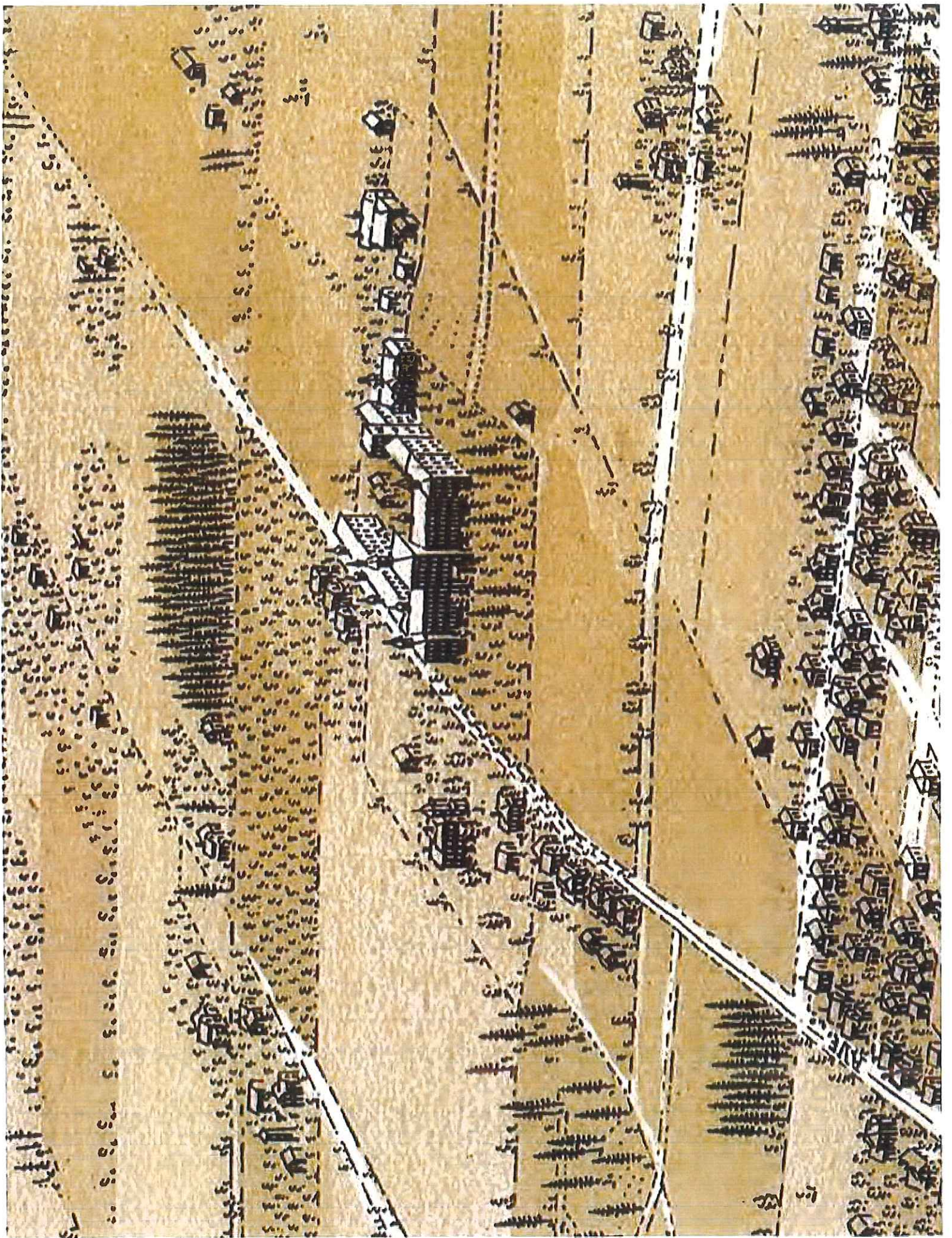
Image 57 of Sanborn Fire Insurance Map from Salem, Marion County, Oregon.

STATE HOUSE OF OREGON

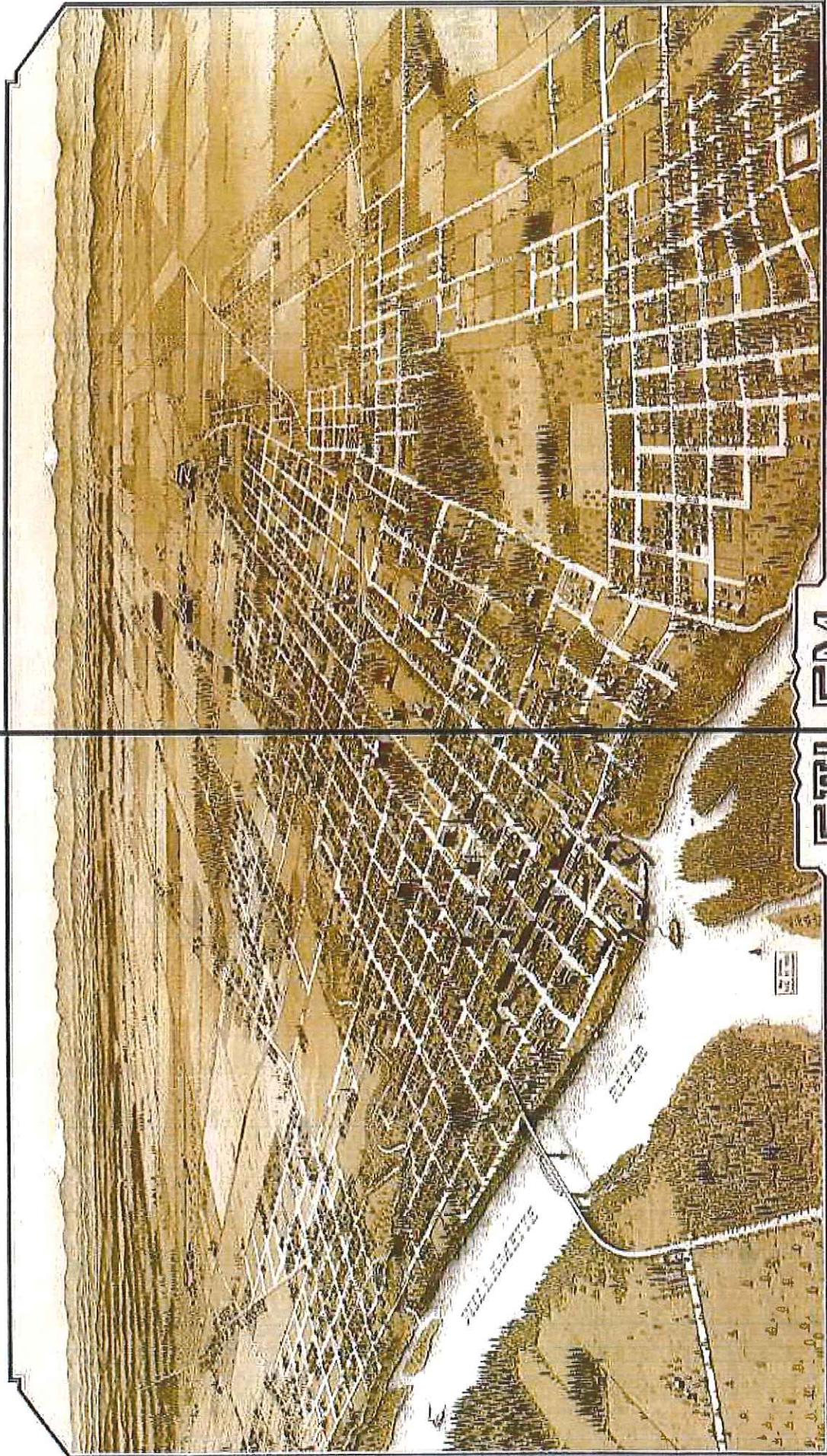
