The Independent School is located at 25381 SW Airport Avenue, just over three miles south of Philomath, Oregon, in Benton County near the intersection of Fern Road and Airport Avenue. Fred H. Seedenburg originally constructed the one-story building in 1919 in the Craftsman style to serve as a schoolhouse for the surrounding area. The one-room schoolhouse is framed in wood and is covered by a gable roof. The building has been used for a variety of functions since it ceased to be a school, including as home to a number of different churches and its current use as the Independent Community Center. The design of the school features typical elements of the Craftsman style including knee braces supporting overhanging eves. The school's setting is rural with minimal vegetation and very few surrounding structures, similar to its original setting. The construction of the schoolhouse is mostly original with few alterations to the building with the exception of an addition on the east side of the original volume circa 1930, on the site of the Independent School, which is used as a pump house for the main building.
