DECORATIVE FEATURES: Clipped gable ends; eave returns; multiple-light windows; four Doric columns support pediment roof, full cornice, dentils, front porch; fifteen-light wood door w/ five-light sidelights, glass is colored w/ images of vines and grapes, front door; garage doors are wood panels w/ lights above, basement, west

OTHER: Wood lattice applied to front

HISTORICAL INTEGRITY: Very altered

EXTERIOR ALTERATIONS/ADDITIONS: Metal shingle roof; all wood sash windows, with the exception of front entry, converted to vinyl sash of same style; colored glass design added to entry

NOTEWORTHY LANDSCAPE FEATURES: Brick wall SE corner

ASSOCIATED STRUCTURES: Historic contributing garage, south, has details similar to house. Garage doors--multiple-lights over wood panels--are intact, however the roof is metal shingle.

KNOWN ARCHAEOLOGICAL FEATURES: None

SETTING: SW corner of 15th Street & Lexington Avenue; faces east; driveway and garage south; driveway and basement garage, NE; lot slopes south and east

SIGNIFICANCE: Architecture

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: This house was designed for and by Robert Rennesselaer Bartlett. The approximately \$10,000 house was completed in 1921. Robert was the manager of the Port of Astoria from 1915 through 1947. He was also a charter member of the Astoria Country Club, where he designed the 1924 club building, and a charter member of the Rotary Club. Robert's other buildings include the Port of Astoria piers and the Masonic Temple. He lived in this house with his wife Katherine, son Robert Jr. and two daughters Philena and Louise until 1942. Harvey and Marilyn Loop bought the house then and lived there until Harvey's death in 1977. Harvey was a well-known jeweler and part-owner of Loop-Jacobsen Jewelers. His daughter Maureen lives in the home today with her husband Sven Sundstrom.

This National Register house gains it significance for it association to Robert Bartlett and as an excellent adaptation of the Colonial Revival style.

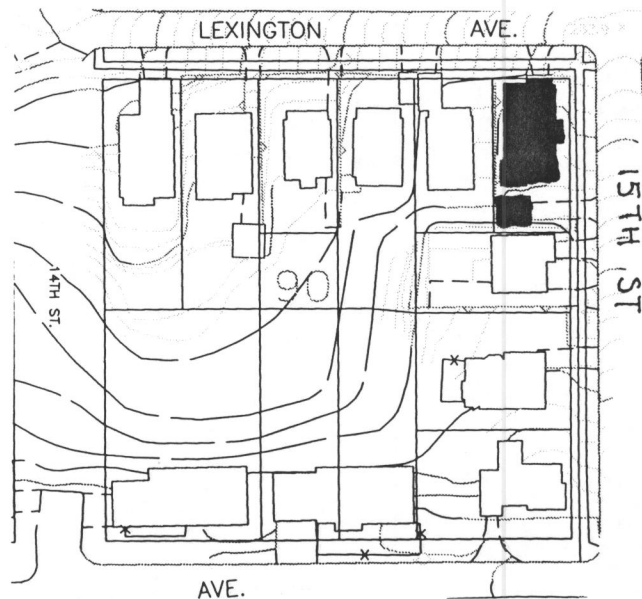
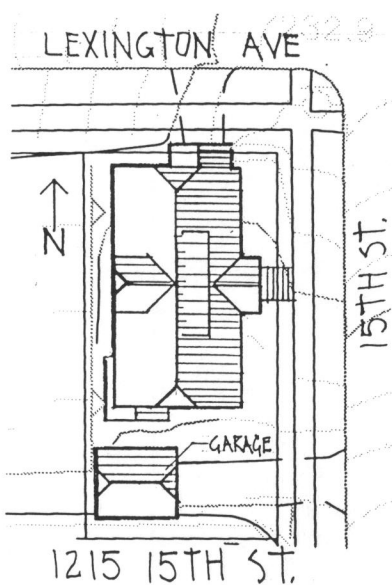
