The Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps show that this building was constructed by 1896. According to Polk's Astoria's City and Clatsop County Directory, the residence was occupied in 1896 by Hans Steffensen, a teamster at Astoria Box Co. Thomas and Blodwen Davies resided at this address from 1902 to 1910. Mr. Davies was an engineer at Astoria Electric Co. Other occupants included Theodore Peterson in 1902, Andrew Rasmussen and Laura Torvik in 1904, and James Peters in 1906. There were several tenants residing in the building from 1913 to 1920. These tenants included John and Mary Mueller in 1913; Peter and Mary Anderson, and Charles and Jennie Johnson in 1915; Orpa and Hulda Hautaniemi and Hjalmar Isaakson in 1917; Orpa and Hulda Hautaniemi and Hilmer Carlson in 1920. The Thompson family including Bertha, Thomas and Gertrude, Thorvald, and Troyer resided at this address from 1925 through 1938. Thomas Thompson was a fireman and later a watchman and millworker at O' Brien Spruce Co. Bertha Thompson married Ernest Bumula in 1925.

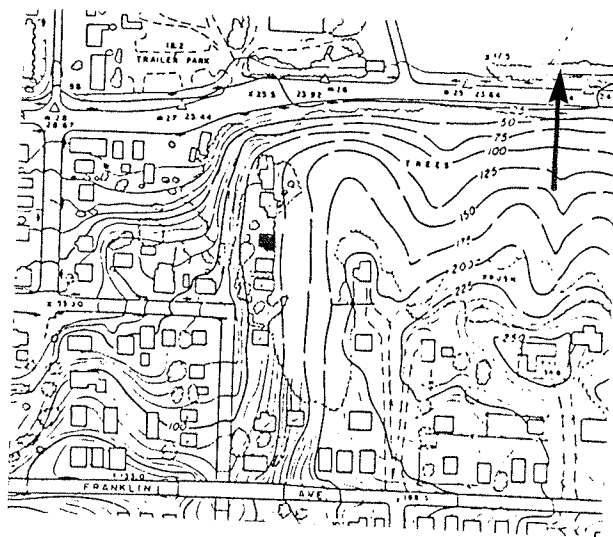
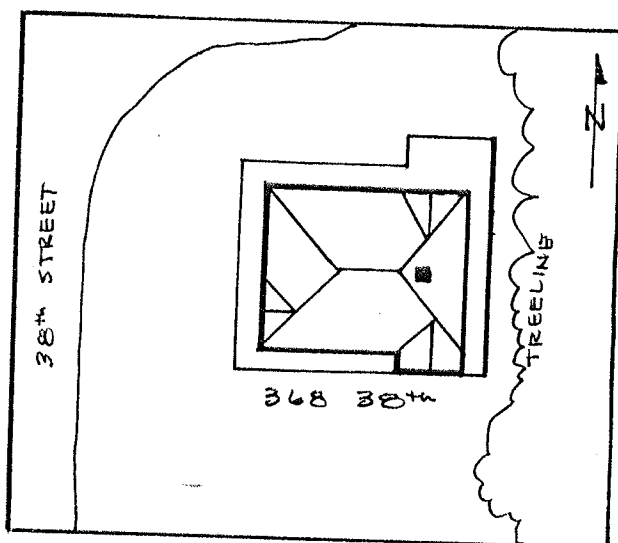
