Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

The former Crook County Bank is a two story building of rough, dressed stone. The structure has a rectangular shape and has formal entry ways on the north and west elevations. The windows are one-over-one, double hung sash on the second story. Those on the first story are large, plate glass windows with three small transom panes above.

This building was erected in 1910 for use as the Crook County Bank. It was given in September, 1971, as a museum by Alta Bowman and her daughters Jean and Elaine.
