Chimneys standing, structure burned.

The present Roberts Field in Redmond was developed from a U. S. Air Force training base, constructed in 1942-43. B-17 bombers and P-38 fighters were flown from this and another base at Madras, Oregon, on training missions across Central Oregon. After the war, the Army Air Forces sold the base--runways, hangars, equipment, barracks, water system, sewage system, and much material--to the City of Redmond, in 1945.
