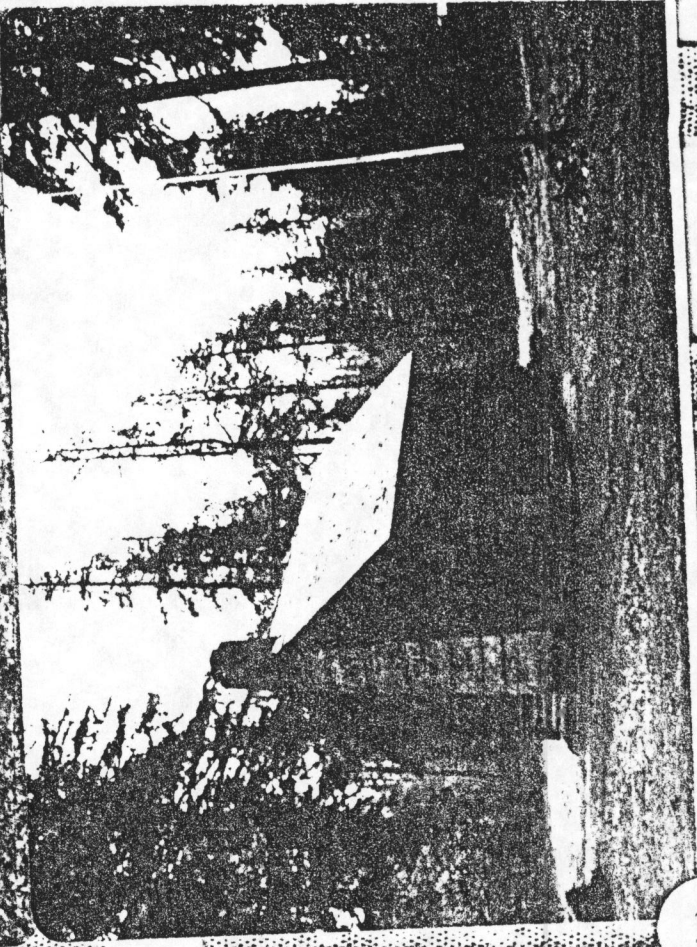
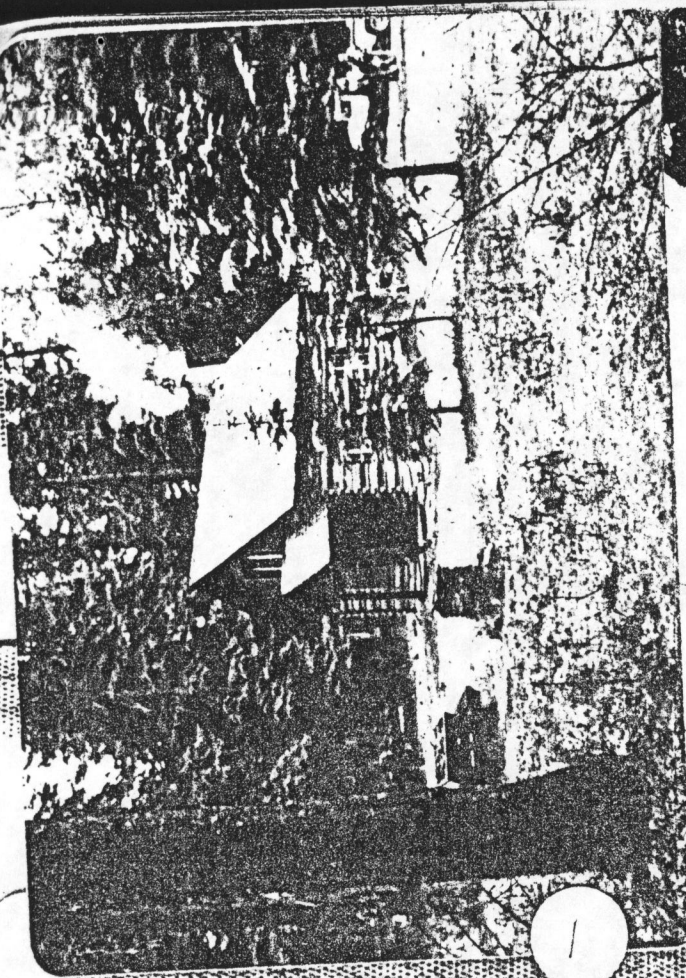
Big Elk Cabin: Steep-pitch, shingled, gable roof; ^{peeled} ~~pull~~ log walls with square-notching at corners; shingled gable-ends; 6-light double and single casement windows; mortared rubble foundation and chimney with grout covering. (Built 1929)

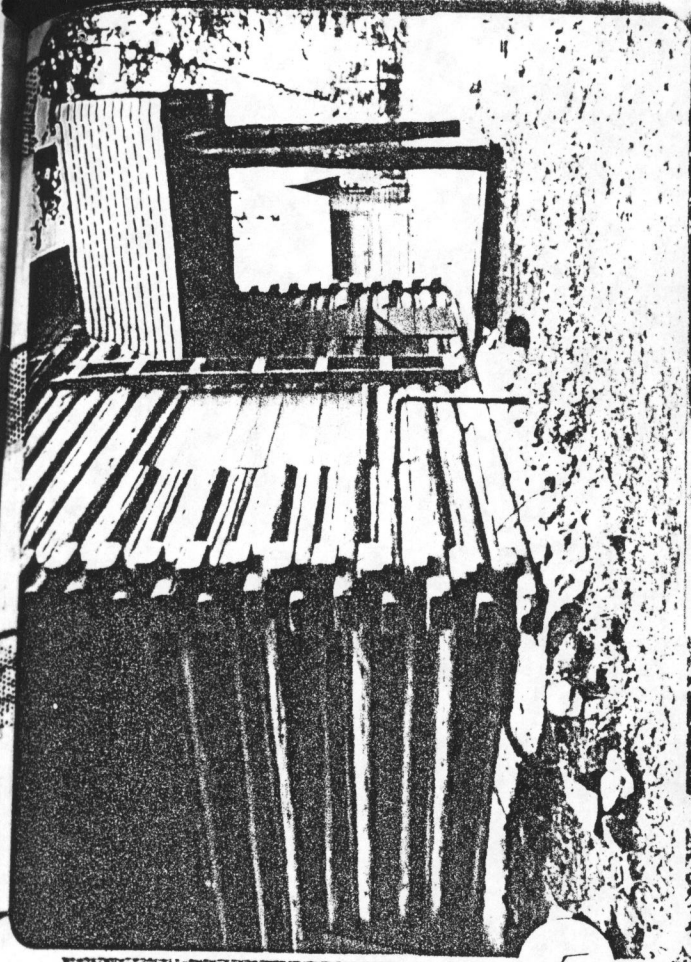
Big Elk Garage: Medium-pitch shingled, gable roof, horizontal "double run" siding over ~~window~~ stud and board frame; swinging doors and one 4-light fixed window; no foundation. (Built 1940)

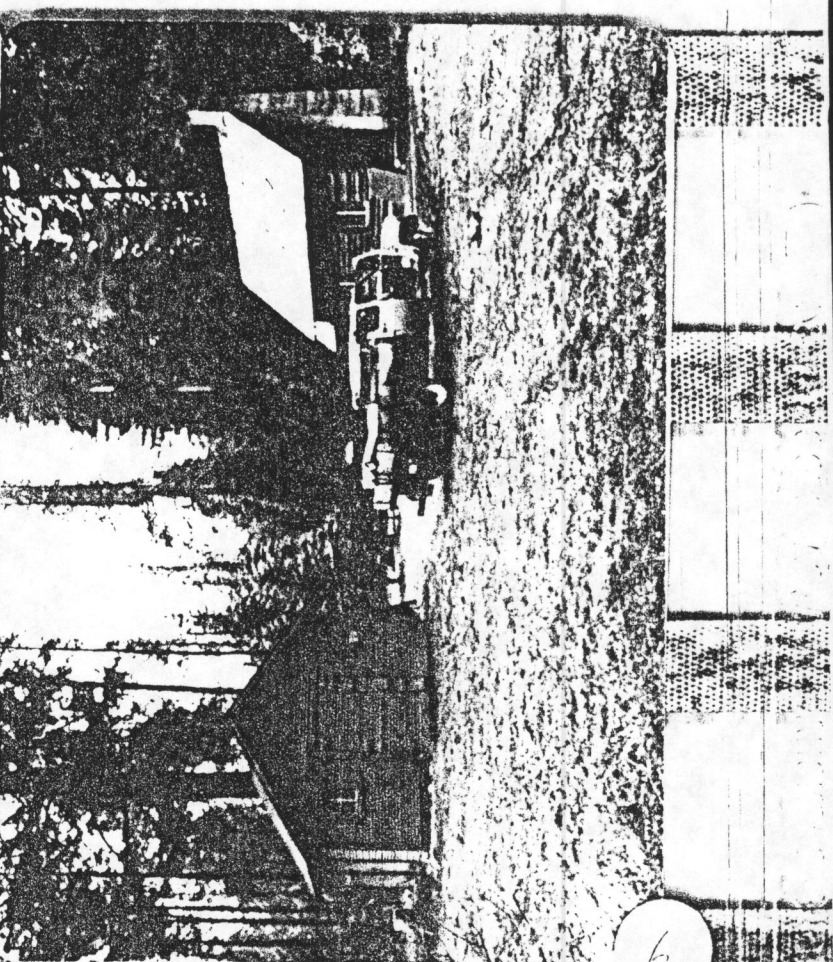
