historical significance:

Hoffman Covered Bridge is a span of ninety feet across Crabtree Creek about one and one-half miles north of Crabtree, Oregon, on Hungry Hill Road. This bridge has an exterior of vertical boards and battens and a gable roof covered with sheets of metal. The exterior boards flare outward at the base. The bridge has portals on its east and west elevations for lighting.

The truss arrangement is as follows:
