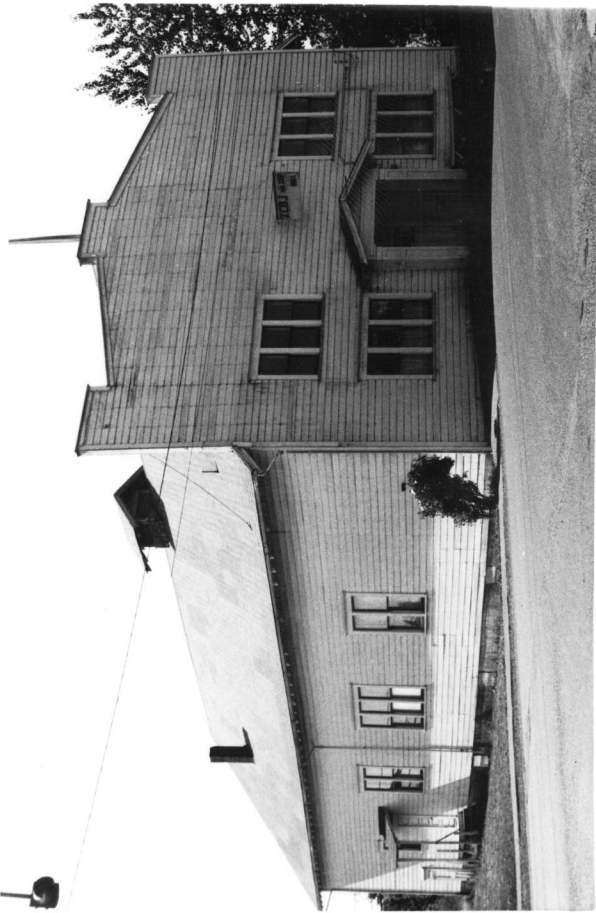

Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

The Bohemian Lodge Hall, Lodge No. 226, stands on the banks of Thomas Creek on South Main Street in Scio, Oregon. To the north, on the opposite bank of Thomas Creek, stands the Knights of Pythias Lodge Building erected in 1914 (see file sheet).

This building is a two story, wood frame structure with a gable roof and false front. The windows are one-over-one, double hung sash and have small entablatures. The siding is shiplap. The eaves are open. The building is set on a concrete foundation. The date 1922 appears in metal numerals above the main entrance.
