

Setting: Building sits on northeast corner at NE Fifteenth Ave and Schuyler St in residential area one block from NE Broadway commercial area.

Statement of Significance: Built by Gustav Freiwald said to have owned a brewery in Vancouver. Irvingon Historic Walking tour touts this building as "probably the finest example of Queen Anne architecture in the neighborhood.".

Corner pilasters with Ionic capitals. Wood shingles at tower and dormers.
