Commerce, Development, in association with Charles A. Alisky: Alisky was born in Frankfort-on-the-Main in 1840 and received a public education and training in the confectionery business. He came to America in 1859, spent some time in California and came to Portland in 1861. He worked for Dekum and Bickel and then established a confectionery business in Victoria in 1862-66. Upon returning to Portland he established a manufacturing confectionery store and restaurant which he operated until 1884. He then invested heavily in real estate and mines in Alaska. He was a member of the German Aid Society and the Volunteer Fire Department.
