The purpose of this continuation sheet is to change the name of a Forest Service lookout listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

On November 19, 2021, Secretary of the Interior Deb Haaland signed order number 3404 Declaring “Squaw” (hereafter referred to as Sq\*\*w) a derogatory term and implemented procedures to remove the word from federal use. On the Rogue River Siskiyou National Forest, this changed the name of Sq\*\*w Peak to Acorn Woman Peak. The Forest Service lookout on top of the mountain peak was known as Sq\*\*w Peak Lookout. The name of this lookout has been changed to Acorn Woman Peak Lookout.
