In 1995, according to correspondence, it sounds like the interior wall between the historic church and the addition was removed. Now the church would like to remove the south wall to add a similar sized addition like the left side to the right to seat the larger congregation. Discussed with Bill that while SHPO can not prevent them from constructing the addition, we would not recommend an addition of that side since the south side of the church is the only exposed side of the sanctuary and that this addition would most likely result in removed of the church from the National Register.
